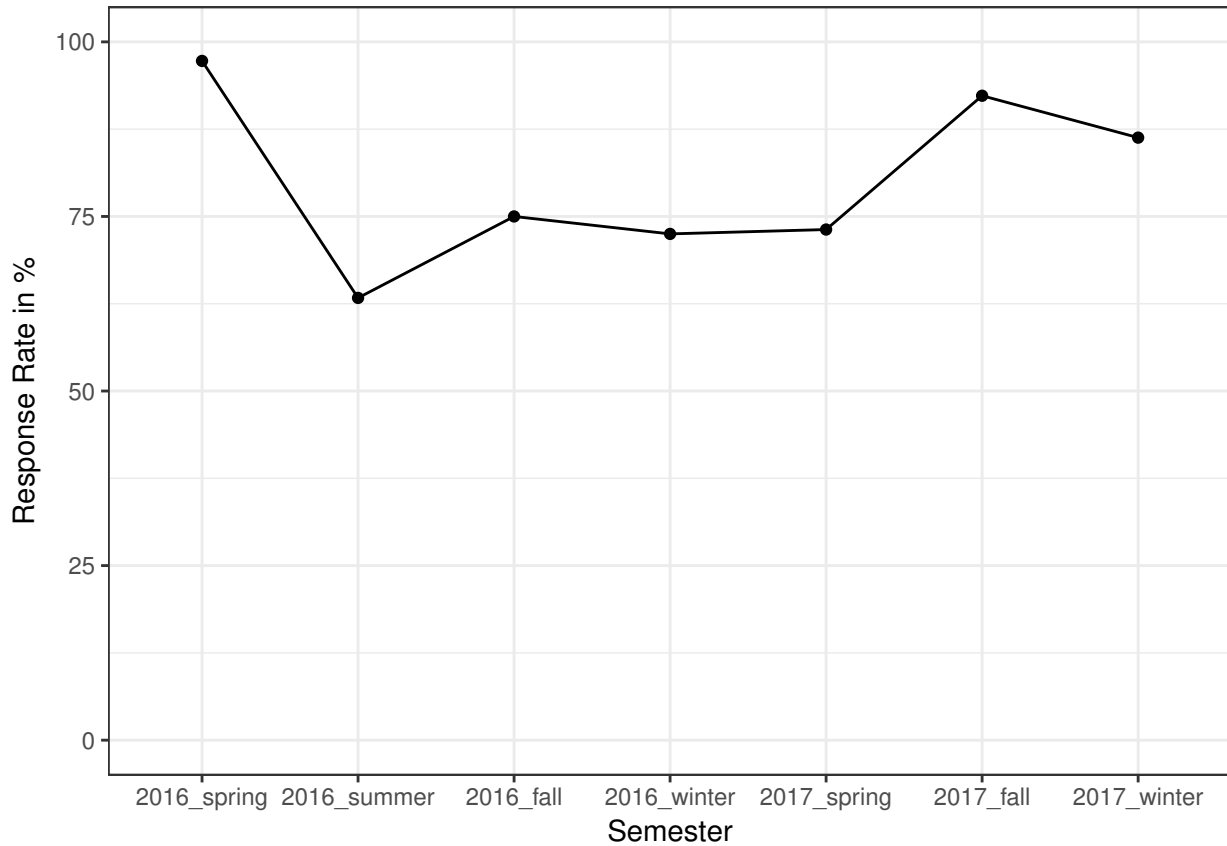
Goal of the report

The goal of this report is to present results of the post-course survey evaluations conducted within the period of March 2016-February 2018 covering 7 terms: spring 2016, summer 2016, fall 2016, winter 2016-2017, spring 2017, fall 2017, and winter 2017-2018. Special attention is given to such topics as student learning (including various forms of assignments), workload, interaction with the instructor(s) and other students, and technical challenges.

Data

The web-based self-administered survey was programmed in Qualtrics survey software. The questionnaire can be found *here*. Survey invitations including individualized URLs were sent to students via email at the end of each course. As surveys were conducted anonymously, it is not possible to identify individuals across the courses. The data includes 146 observations and 25 courses. The maximum number of participants within a course included 16 and the minimum number - 2 students. In total, there were 31 IPSDS students who attended course within the reported time period (1st cohort - 15 students, 2nd cohort joined from spring 2017 and included 16 students).

Average response rate for each semester is reported below:



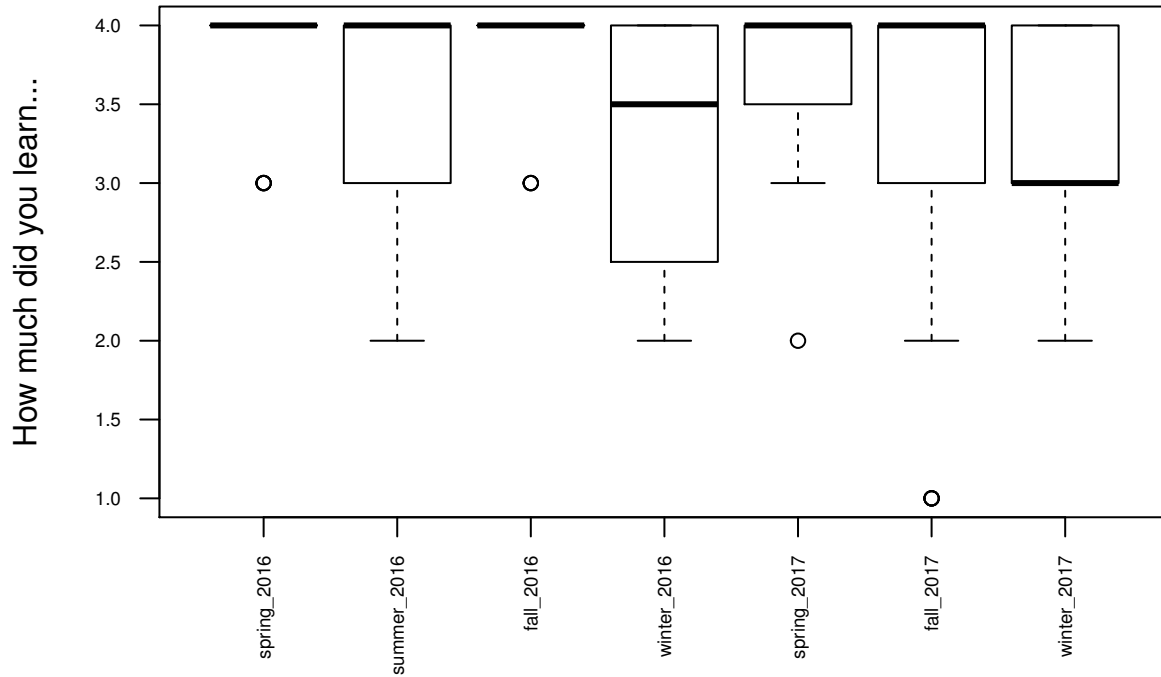

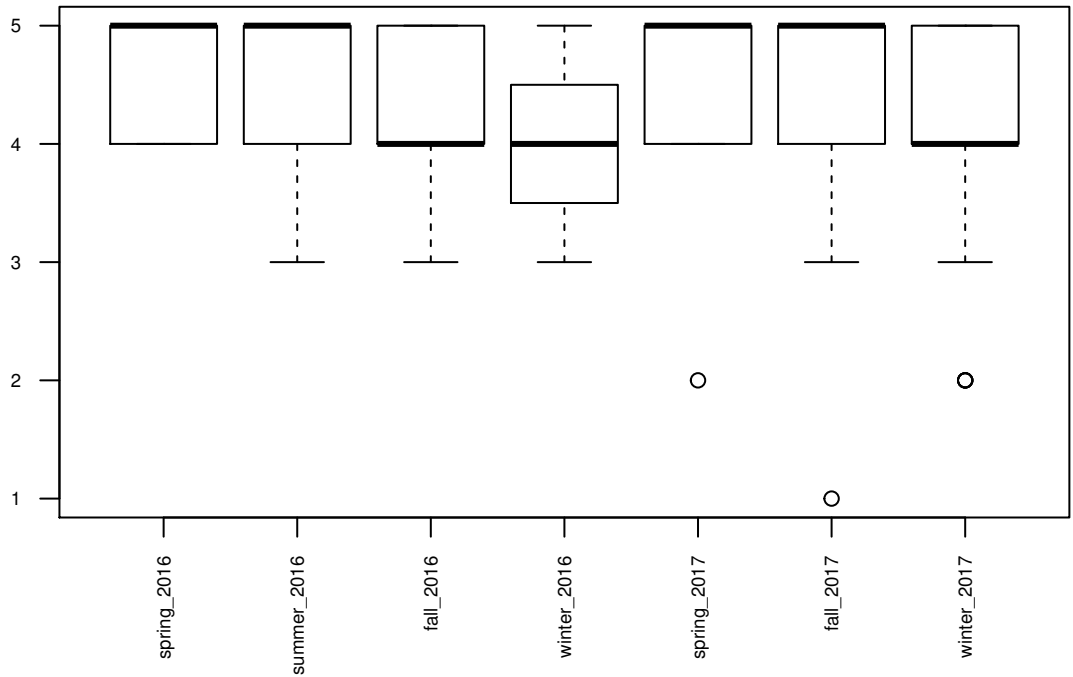

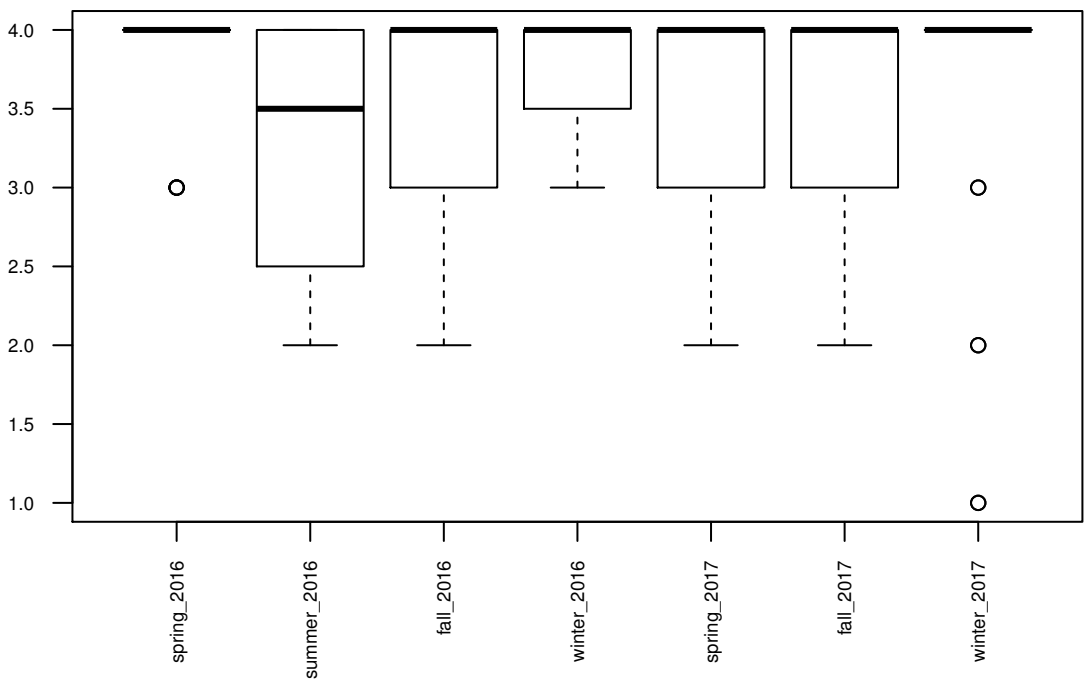

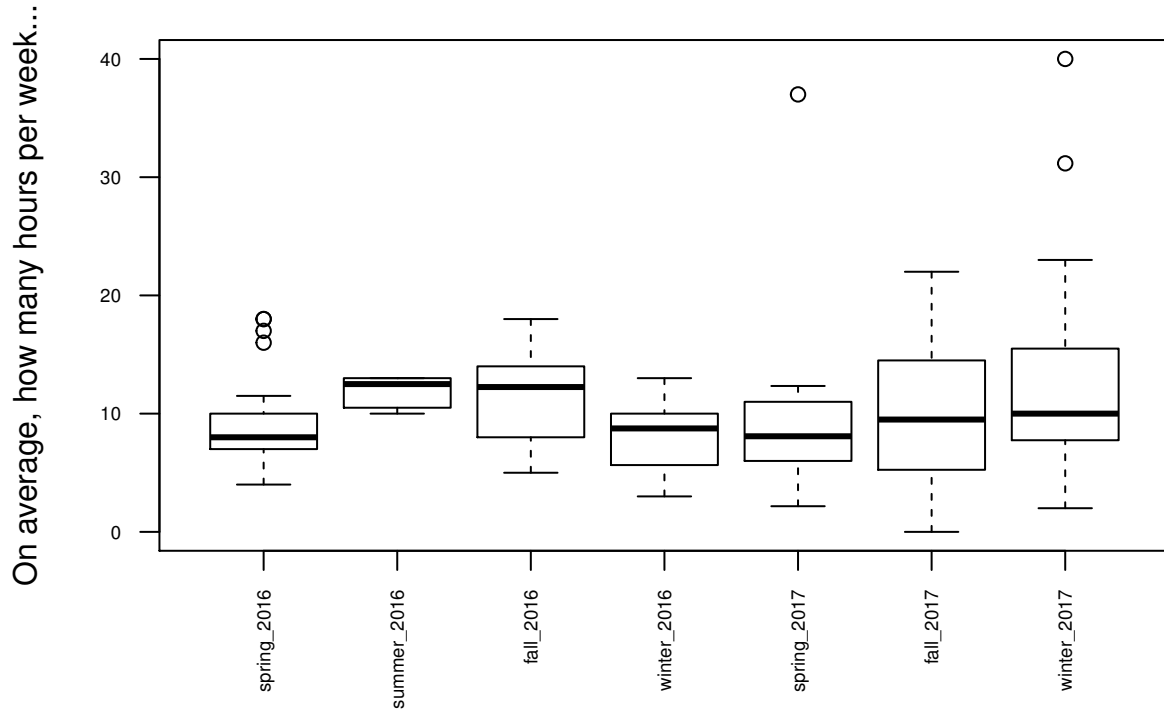


4. On average, how many hours per week did you spend on the activities below?

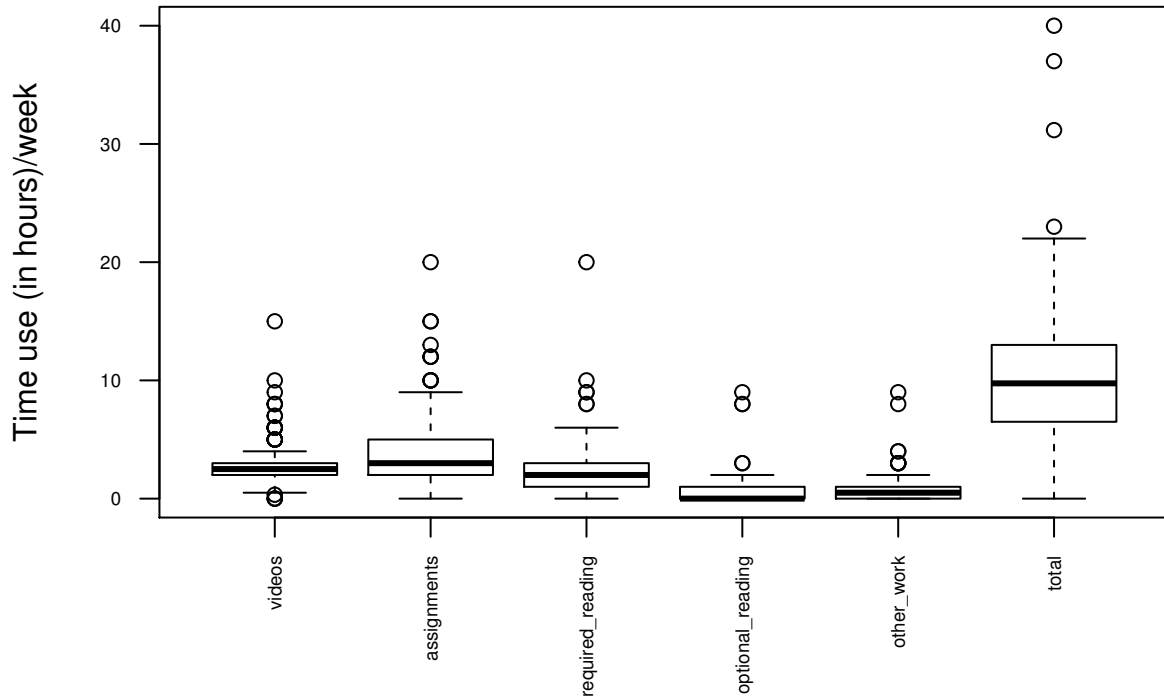

Boxplots for various types of course activities such as videos, assignments, required readings, optional readings, and other course work

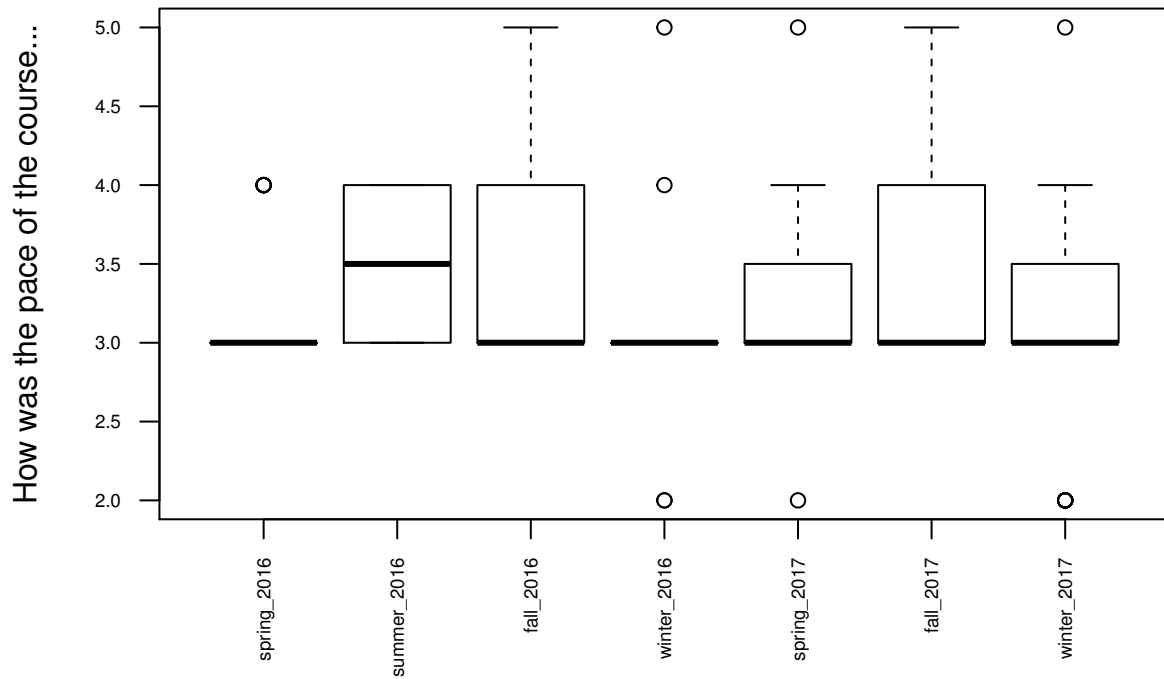

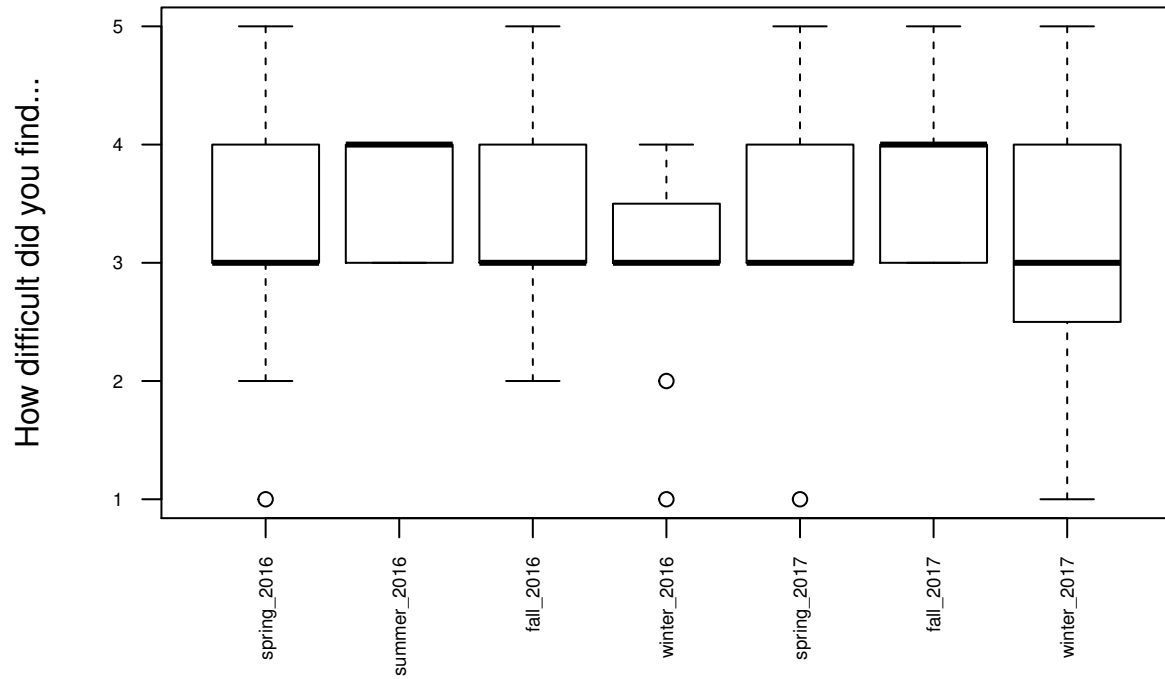

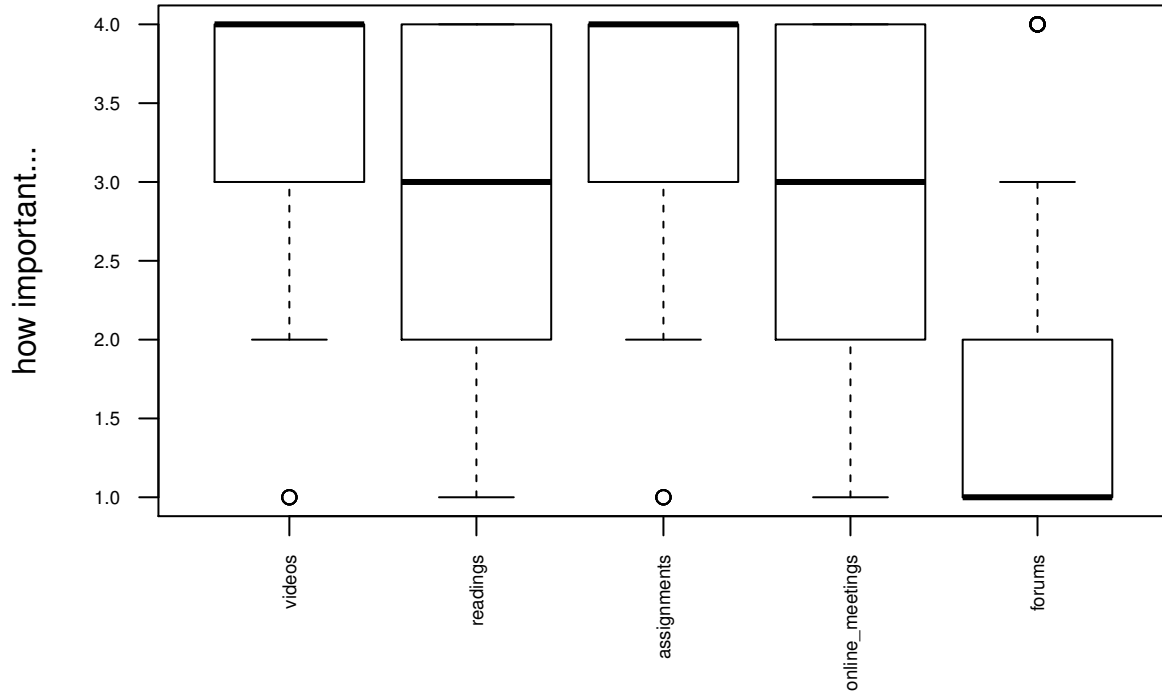

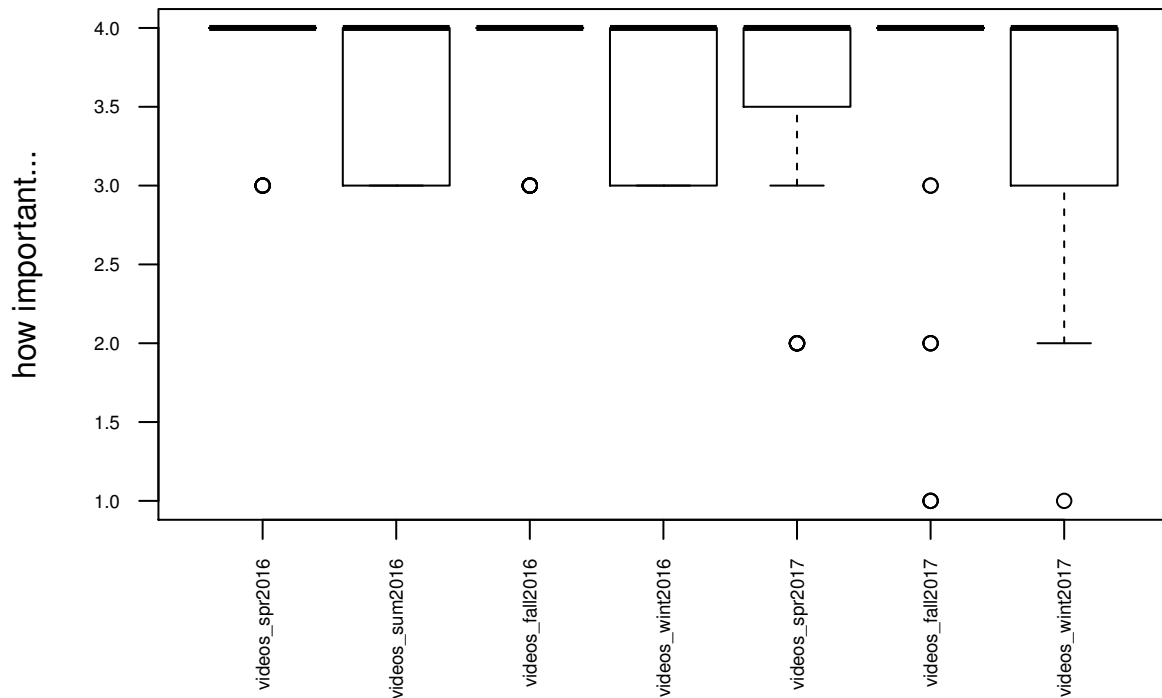

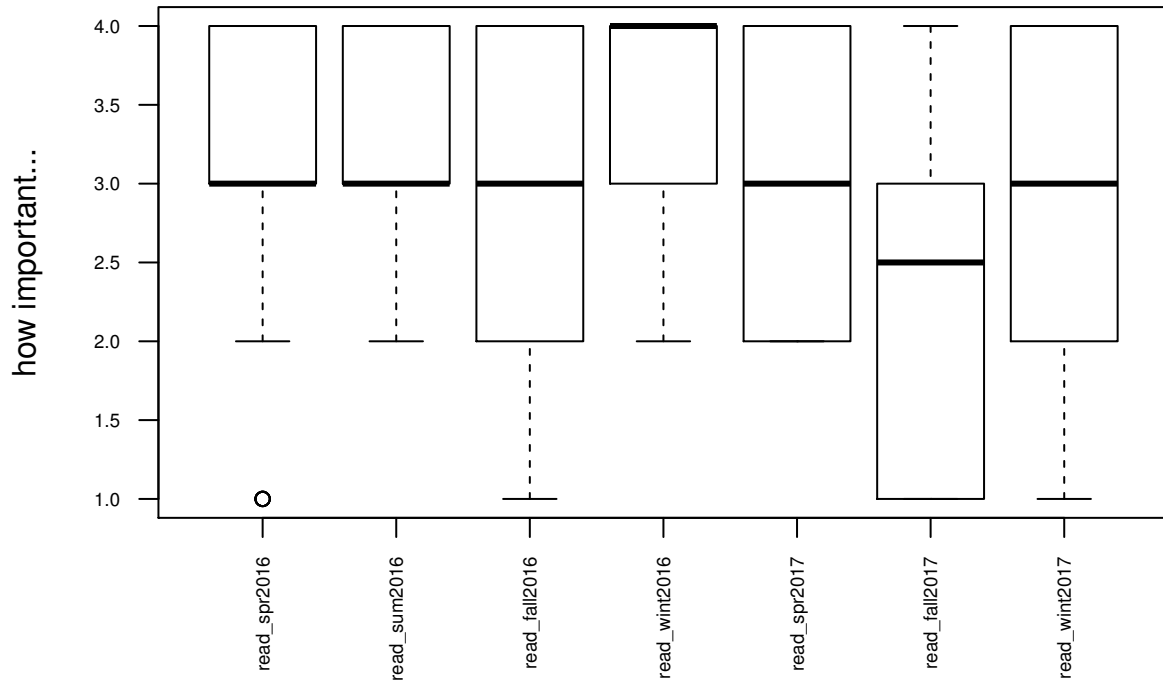

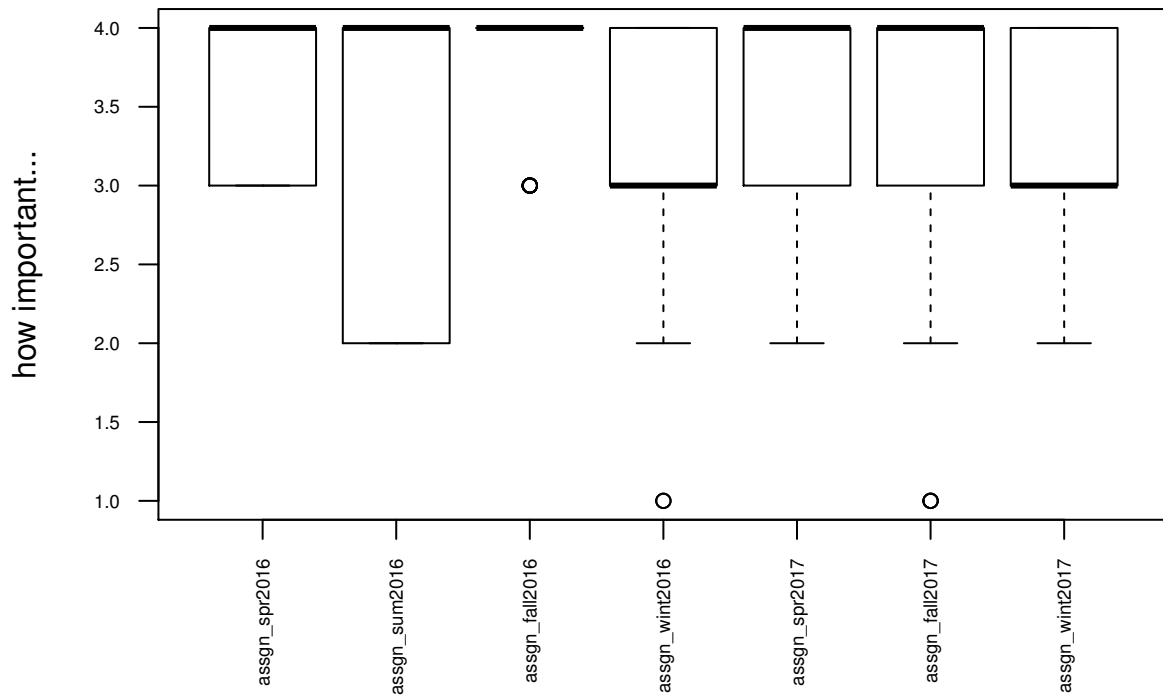

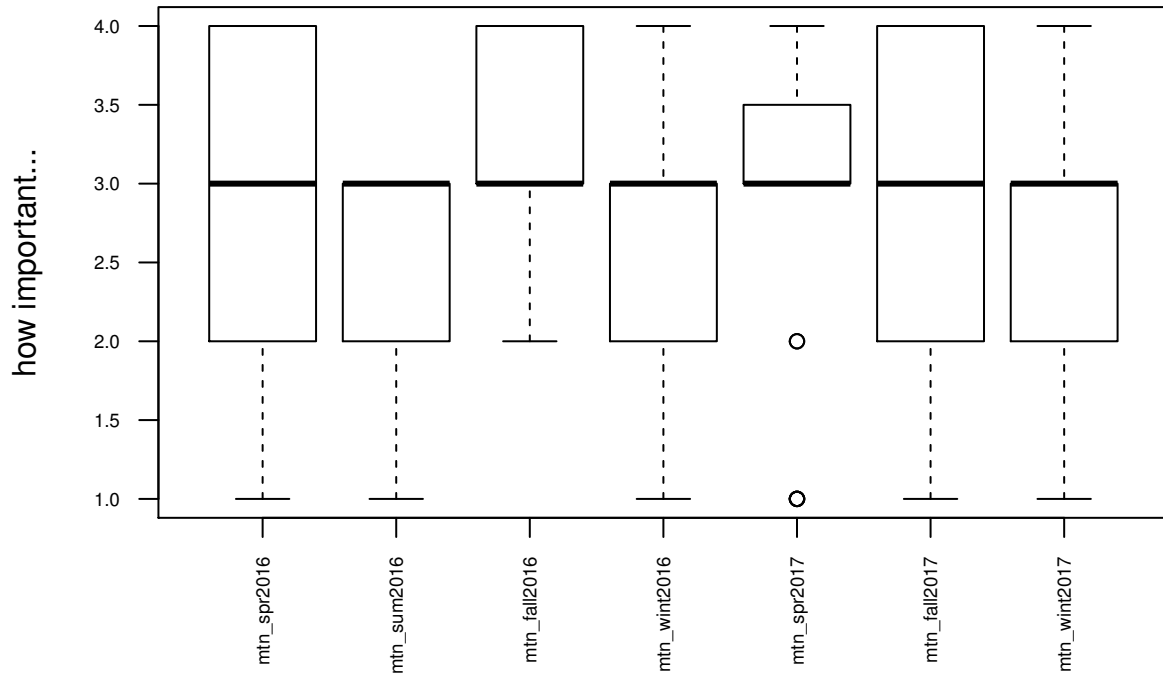

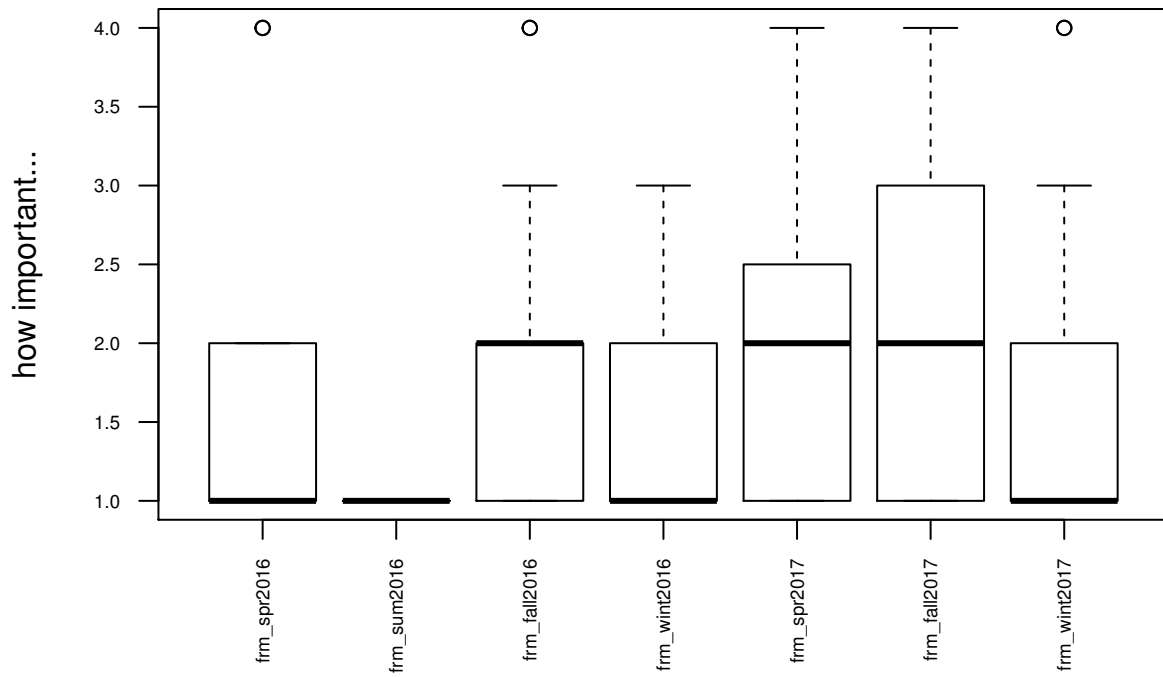

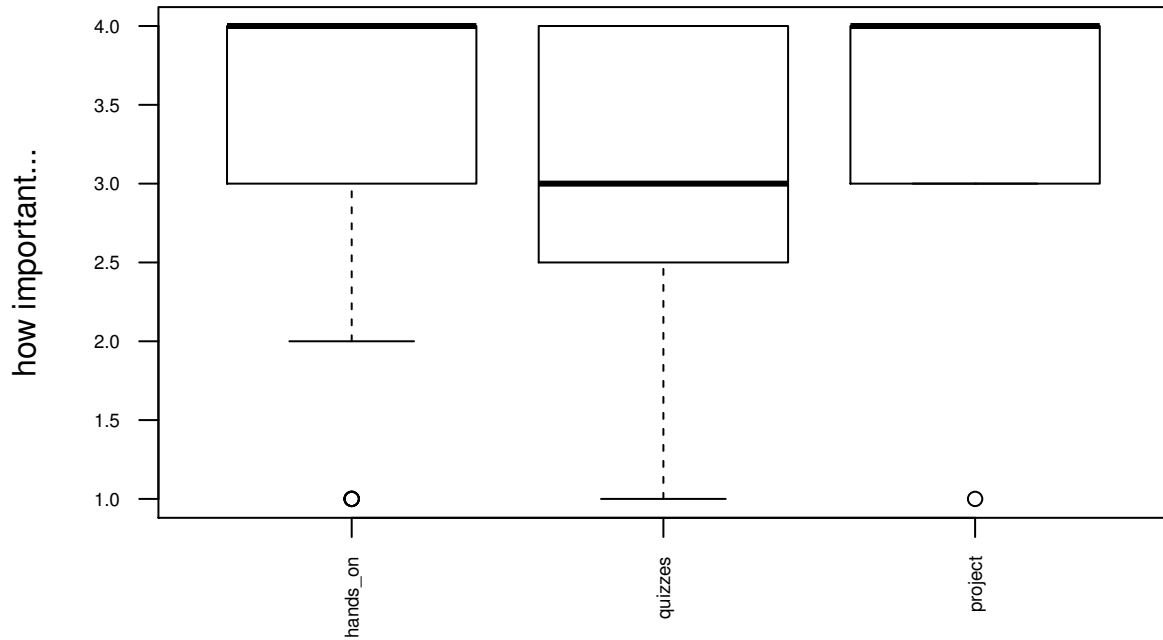

Boxplots: Comparison of various types of assignments - hands-on, quizzes, and project-based

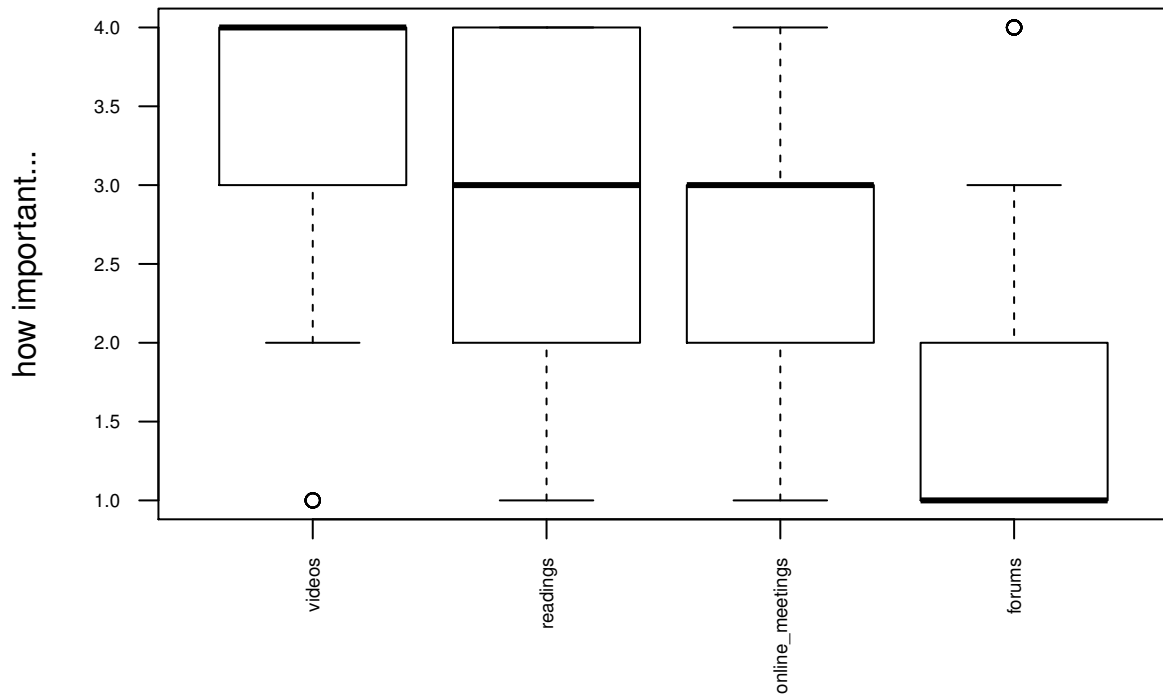

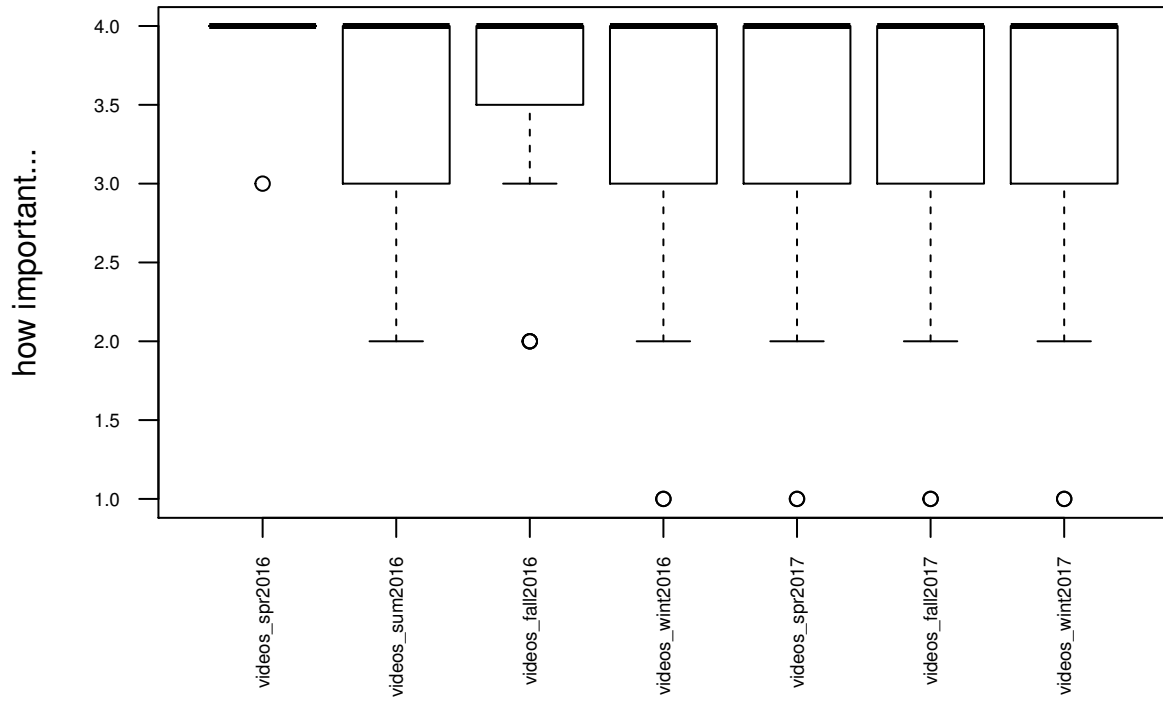

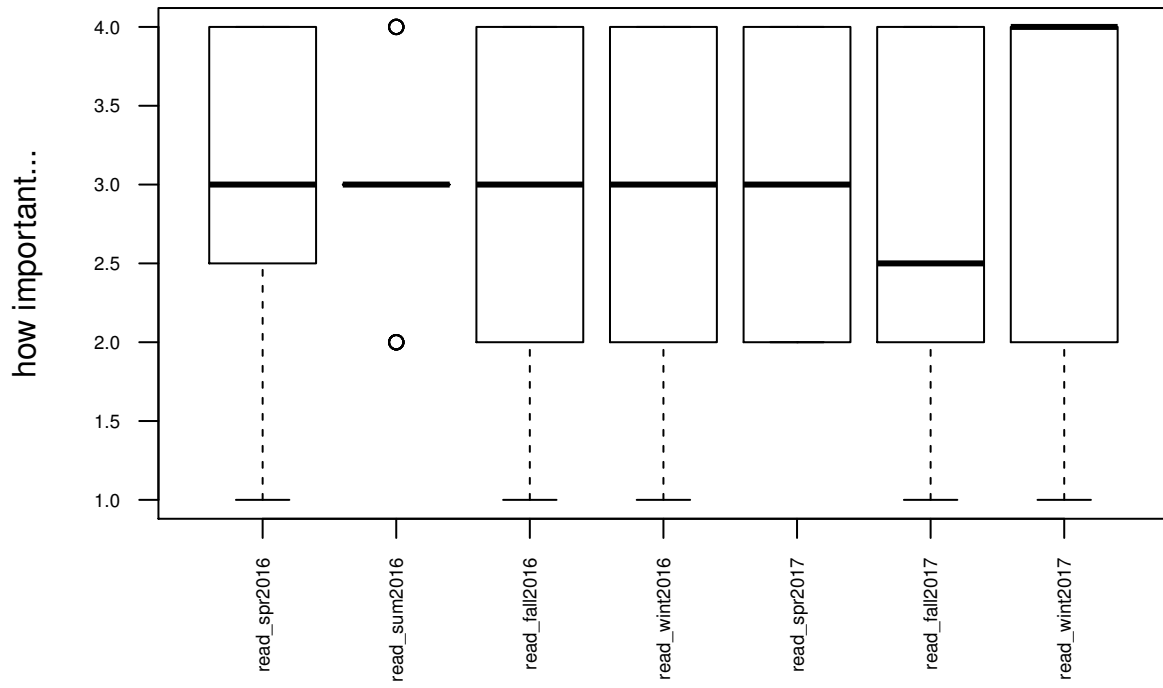

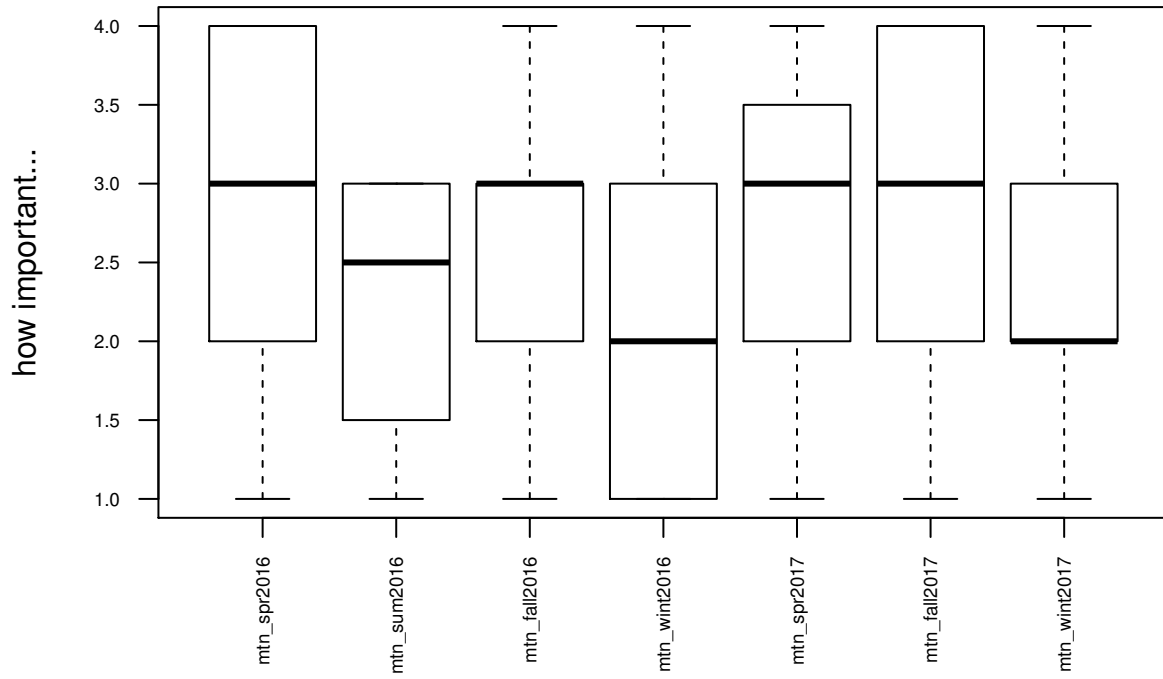

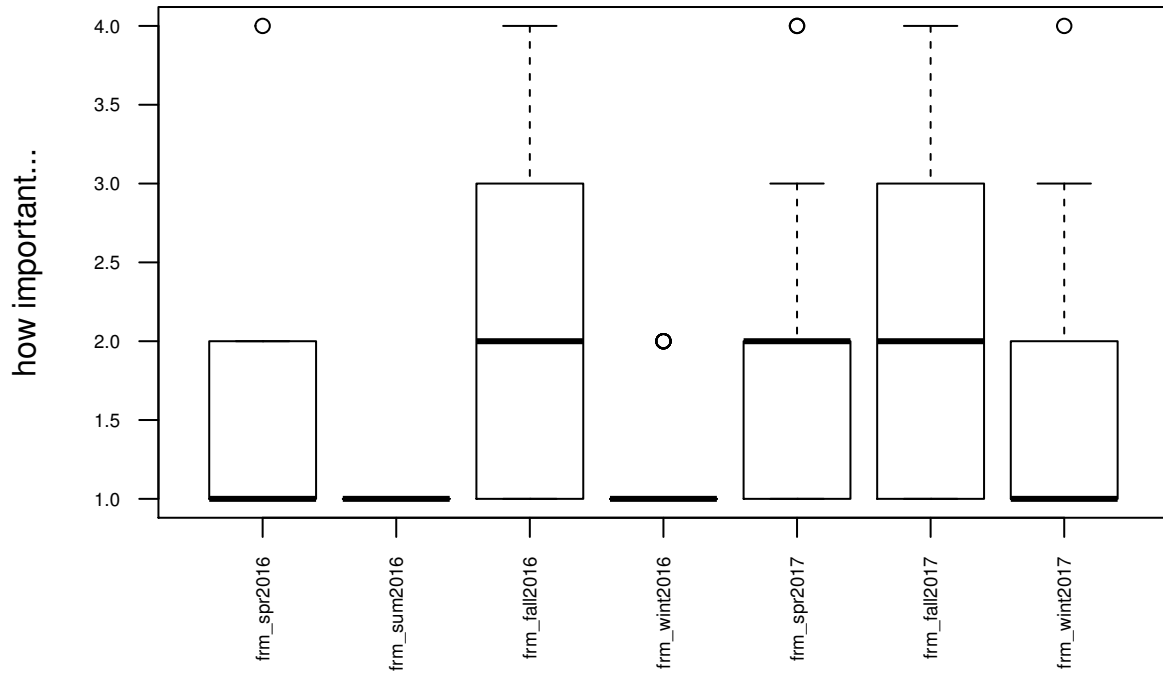

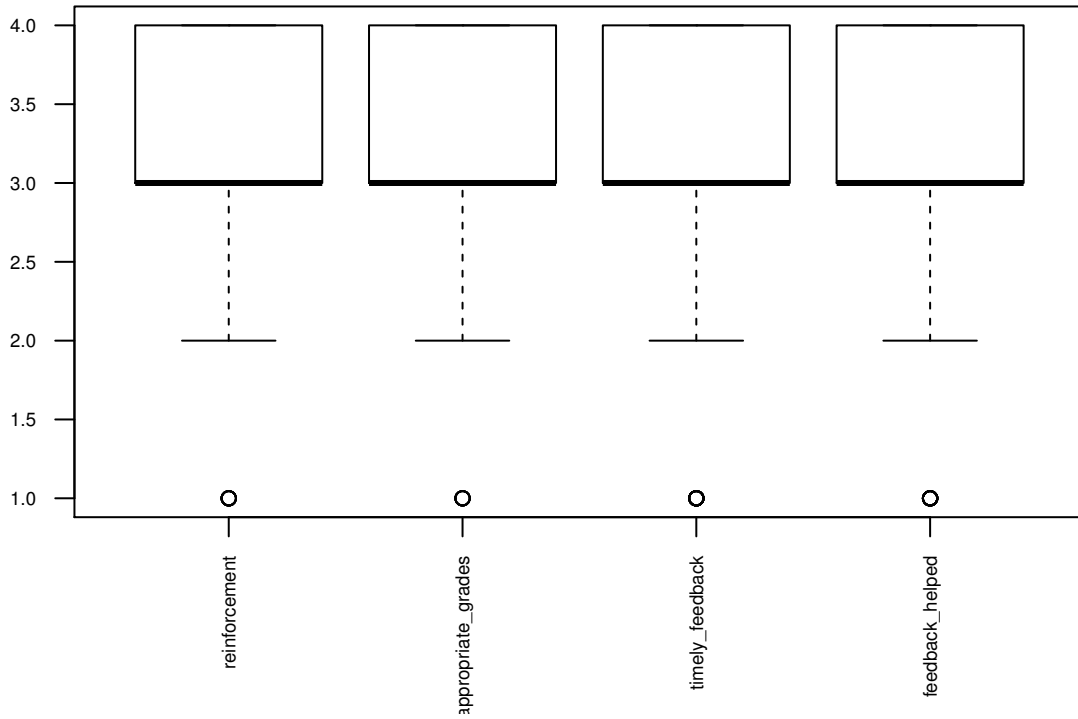

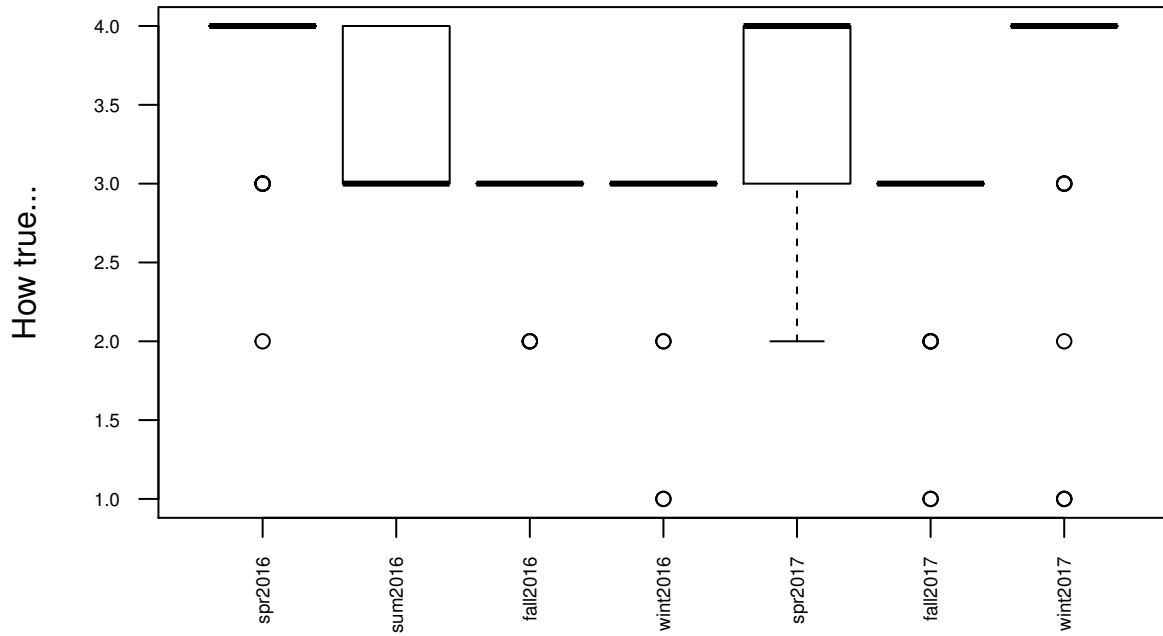

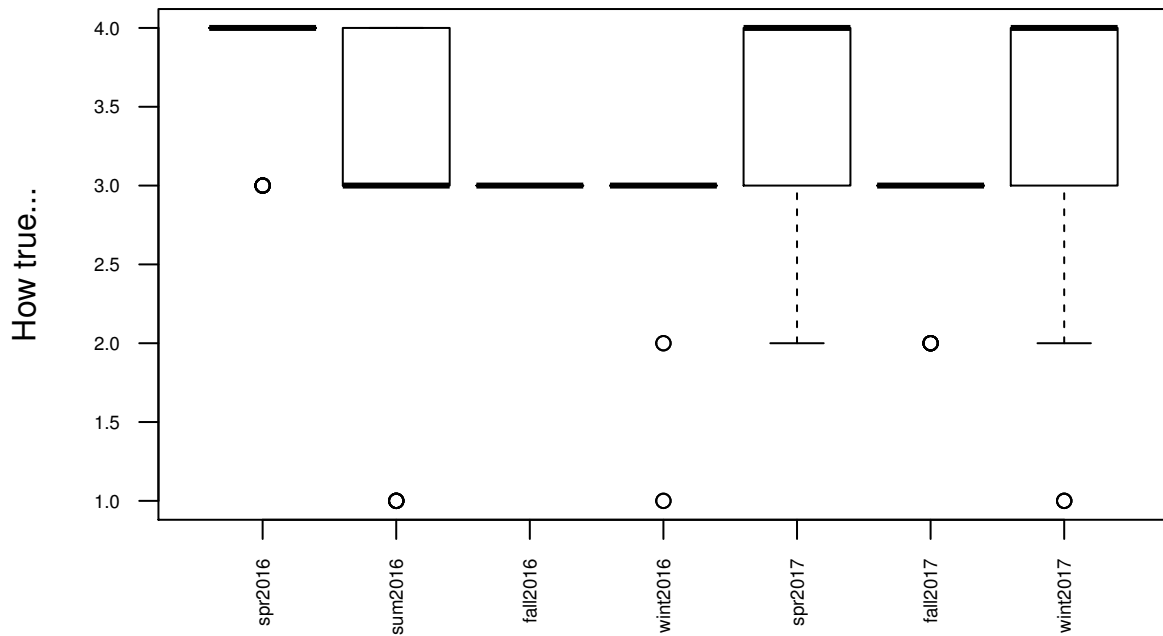

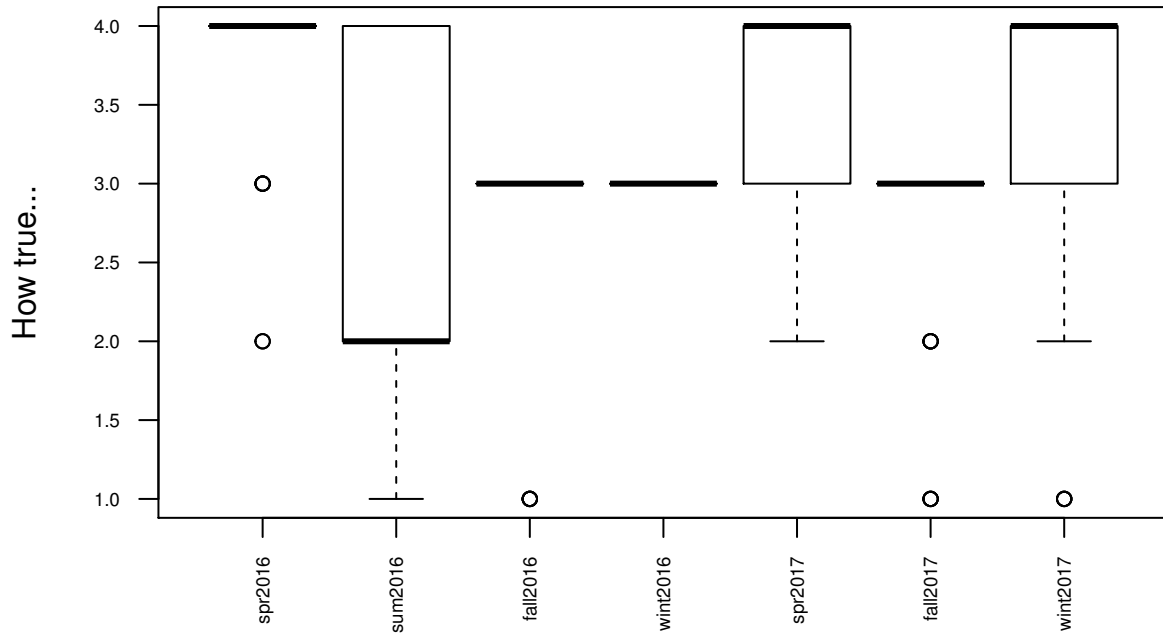
Boxplots for each semester: The assignments reinforced concepts and skills covered in the course



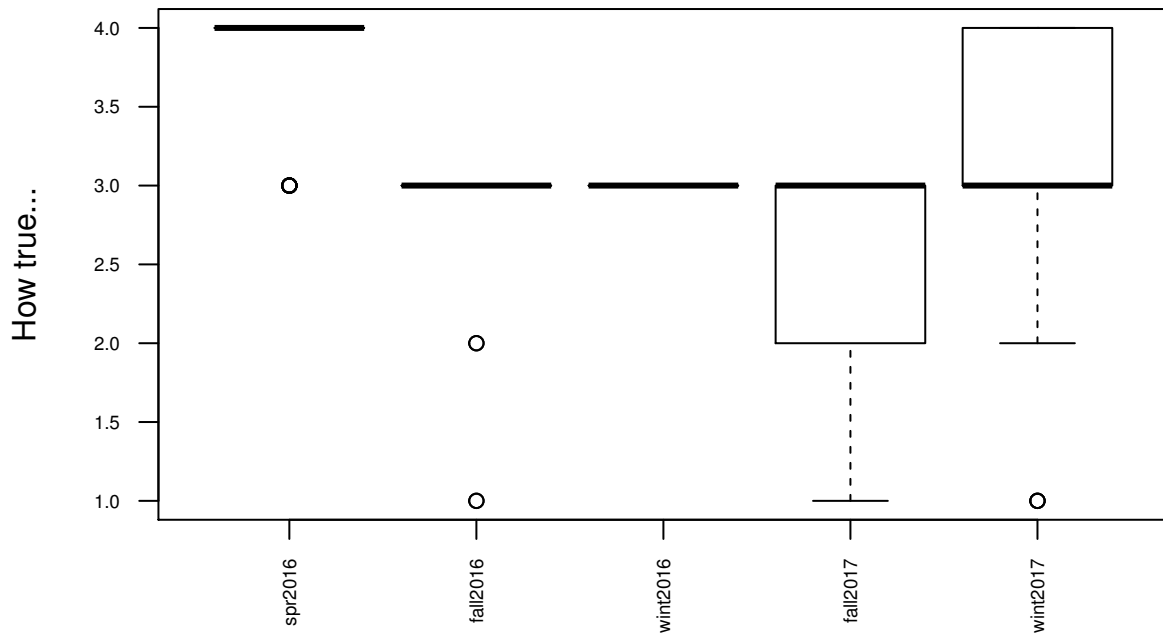
Boxplots for each semester: Based on the quality of my work in this course, the grades I earned are appropriate

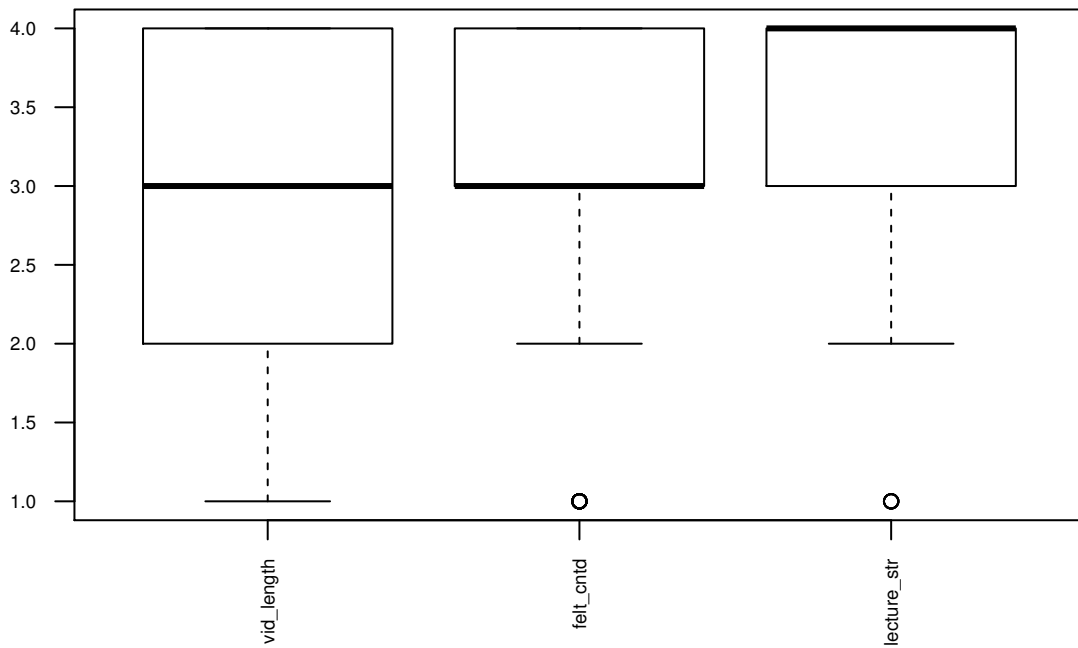

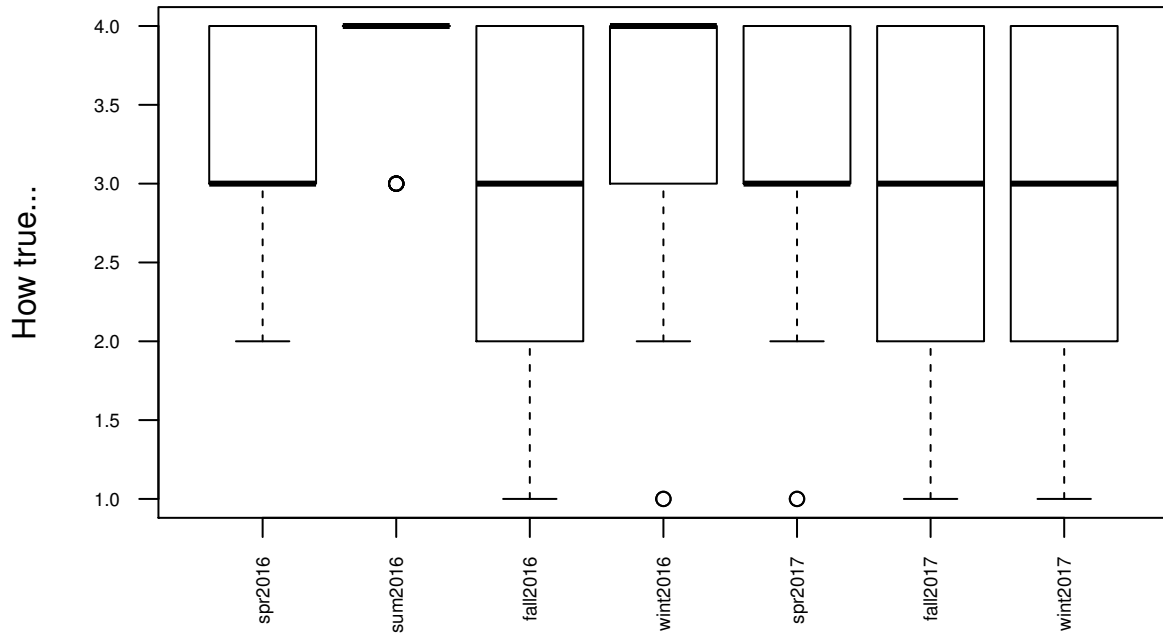

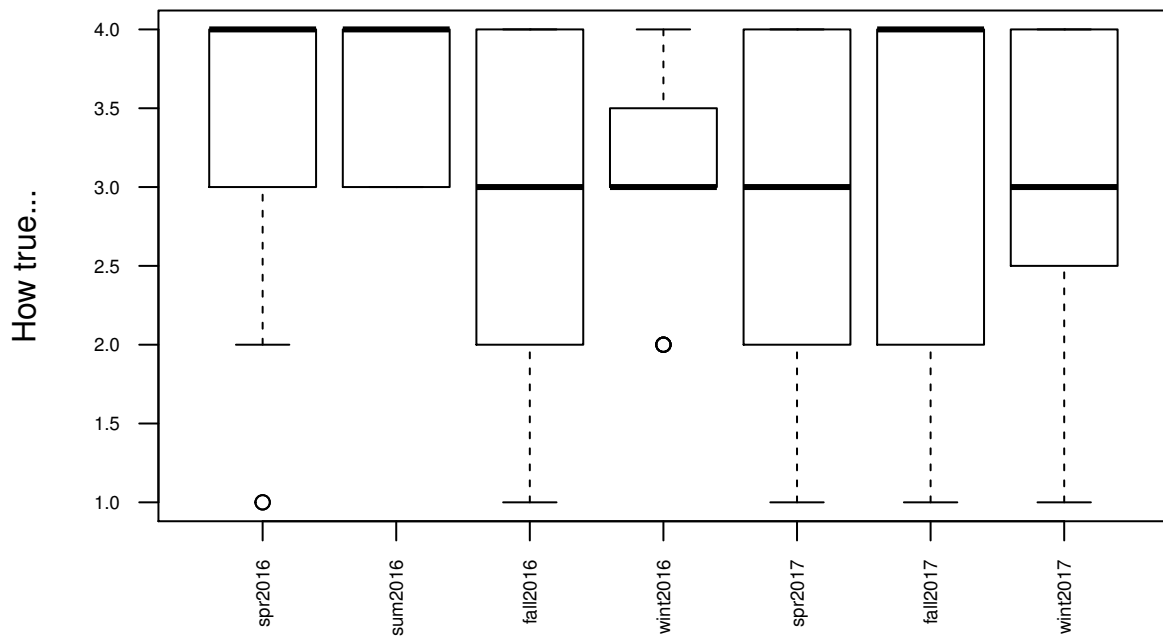

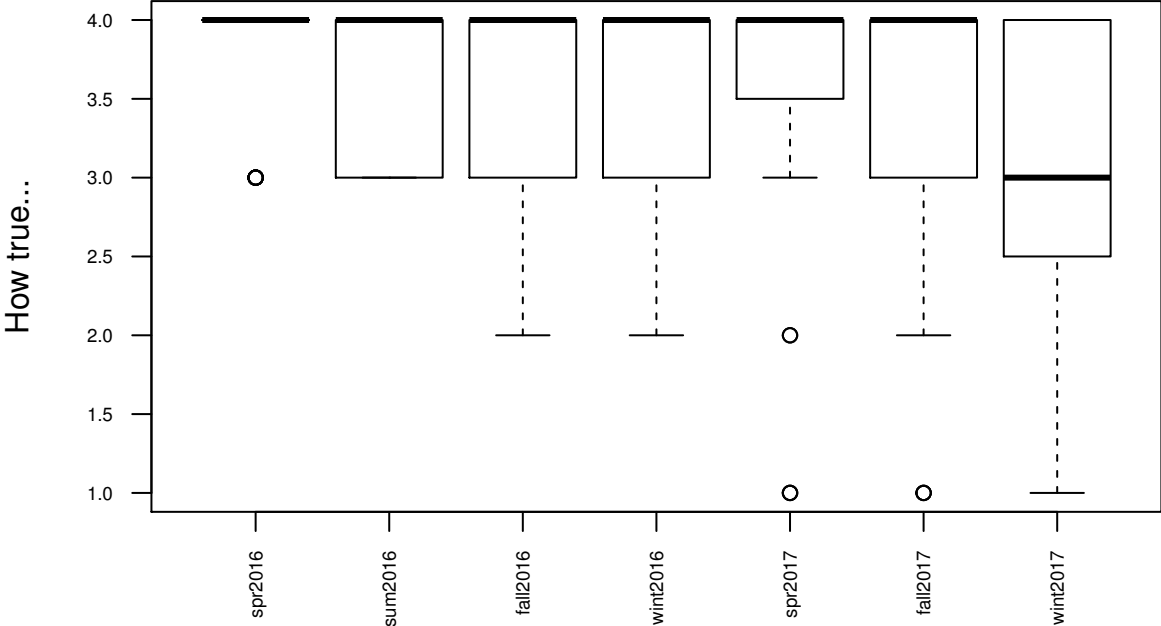
Boxplots for each semester: Length of video-lectures was appropriate

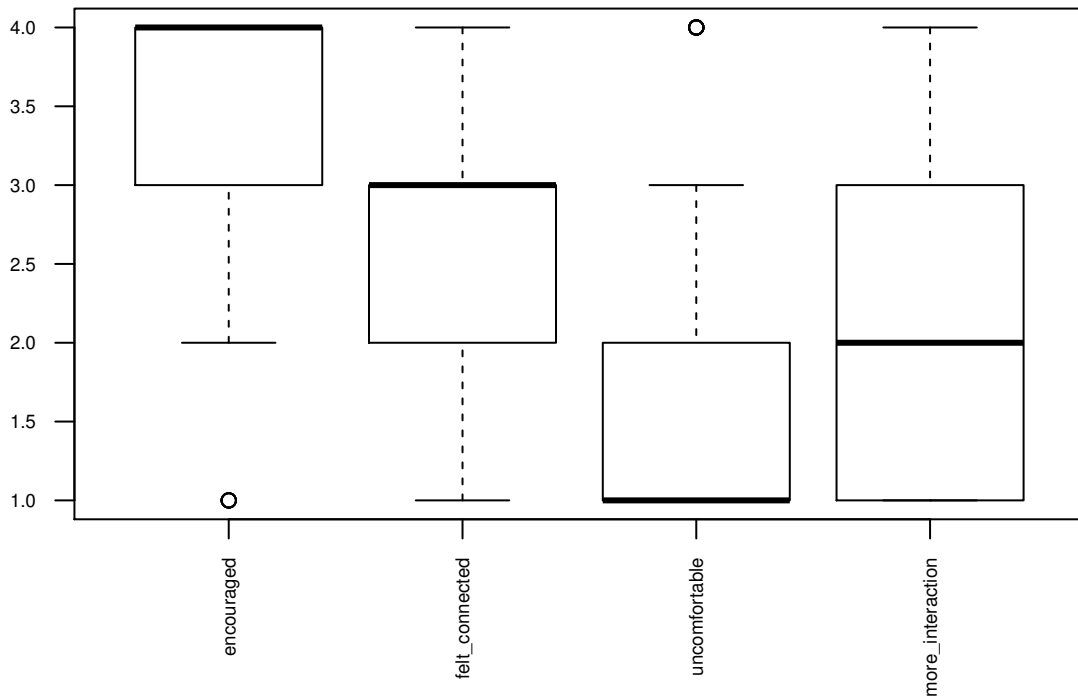

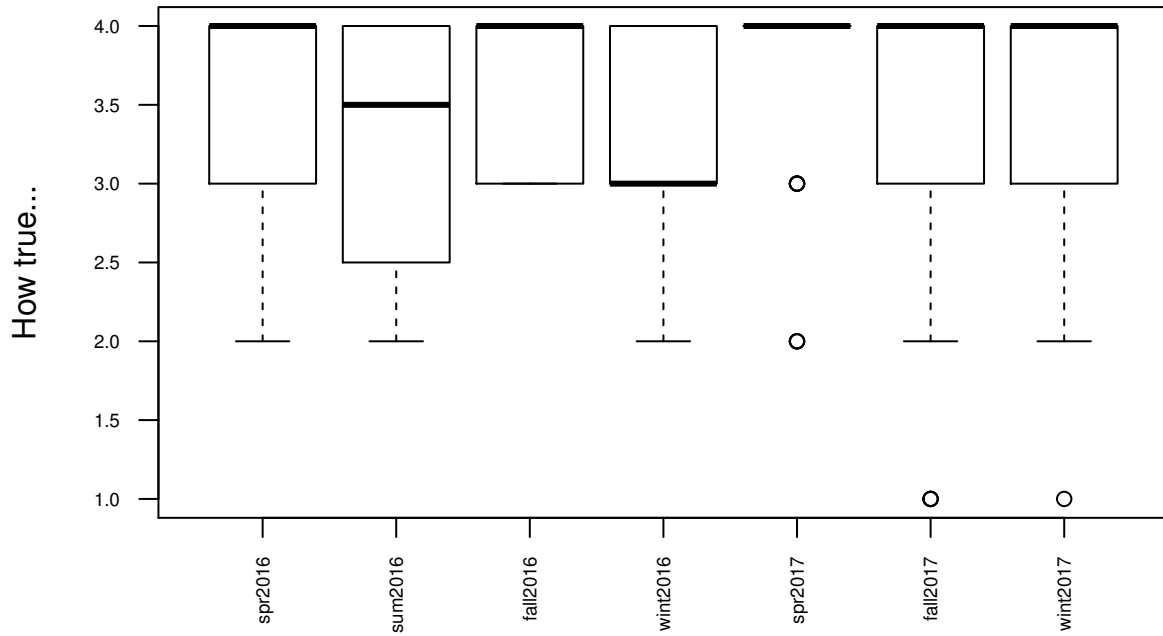

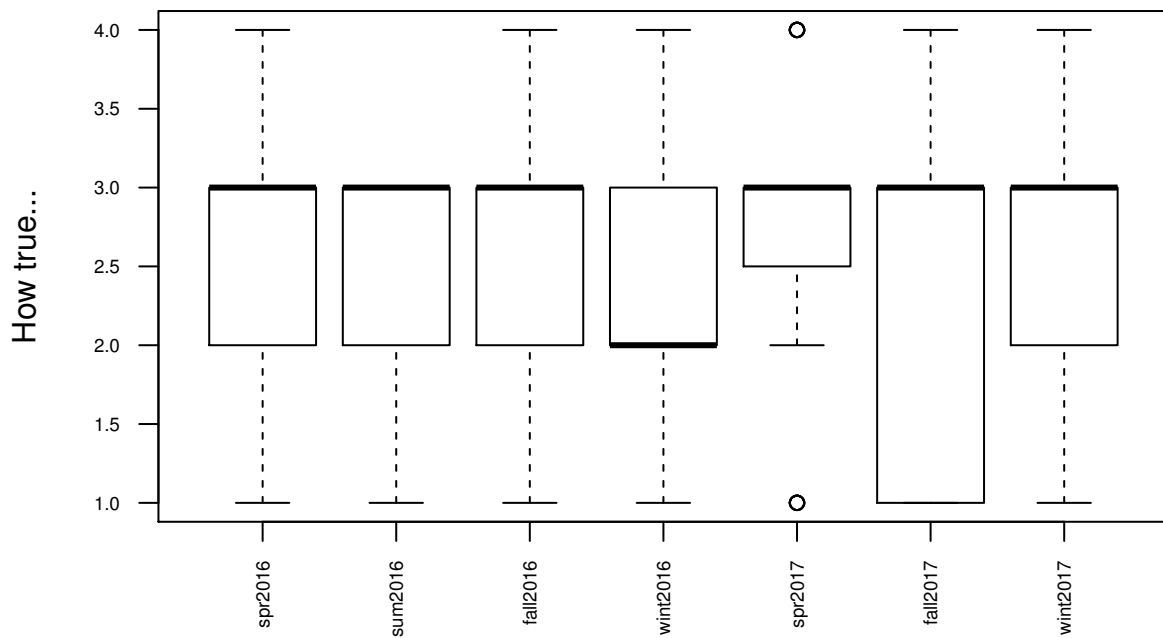

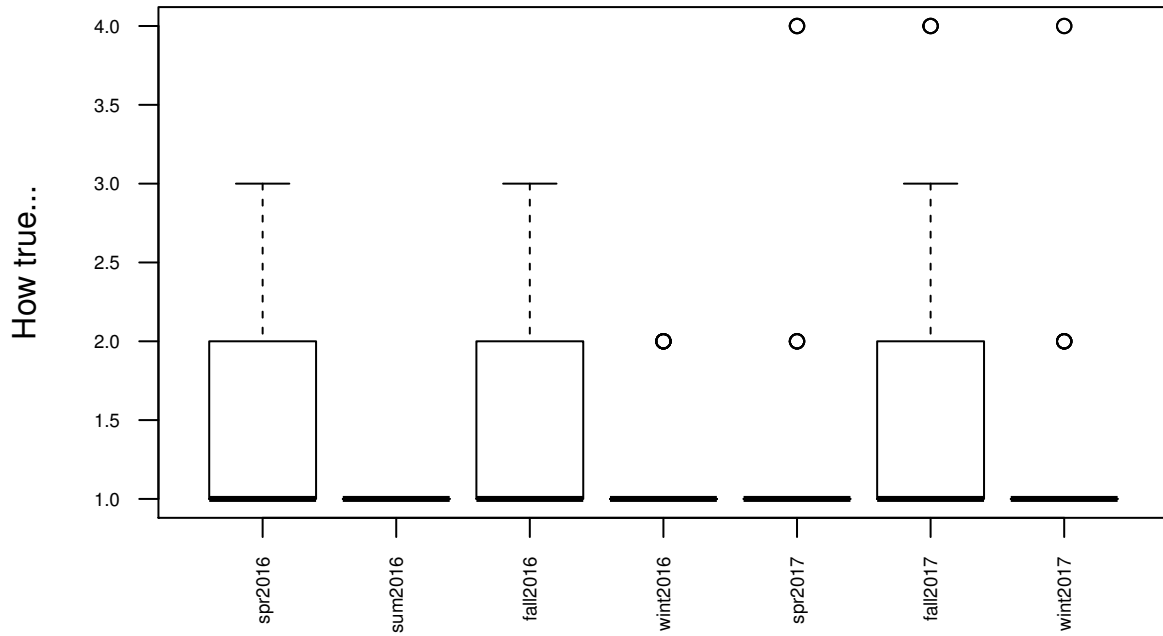
Boxplots for each semester: I felt that I was encouraged to ask questions



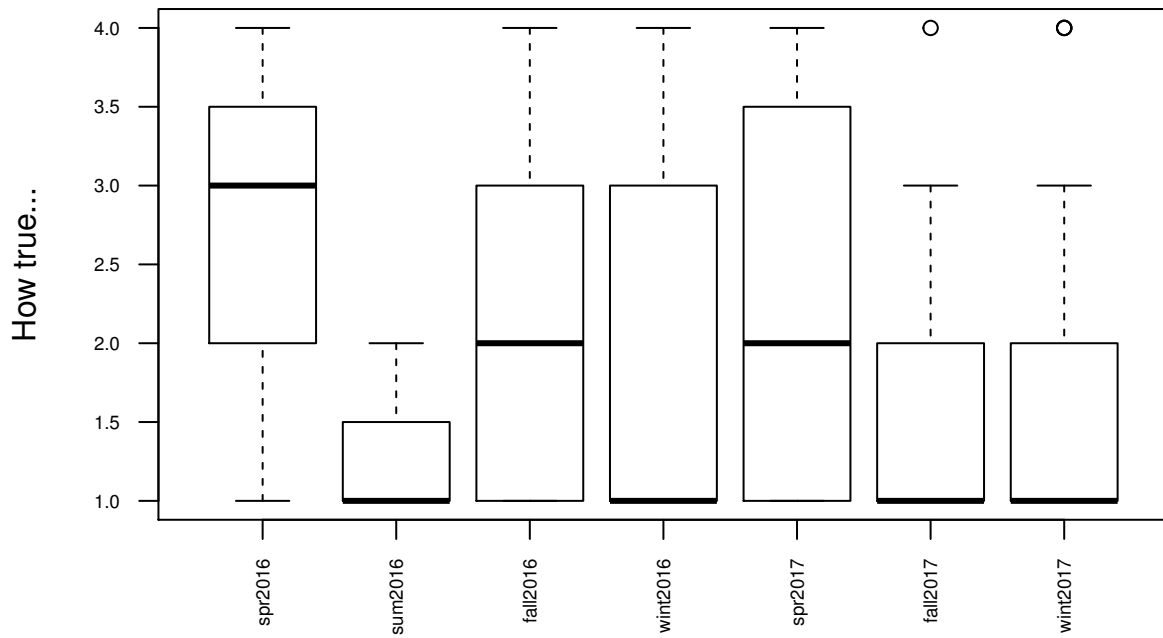
Boxplots for each semester: I felt connected to other students in the course

Boxplots for each semester: I wish I had more opportunities for interaction with other participants



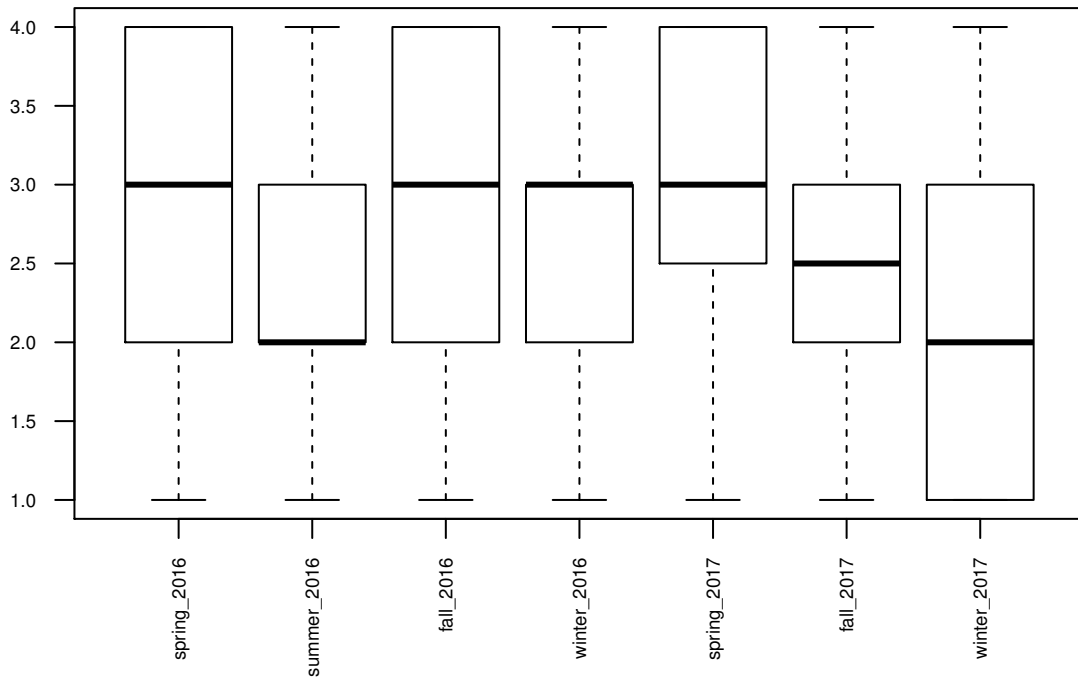

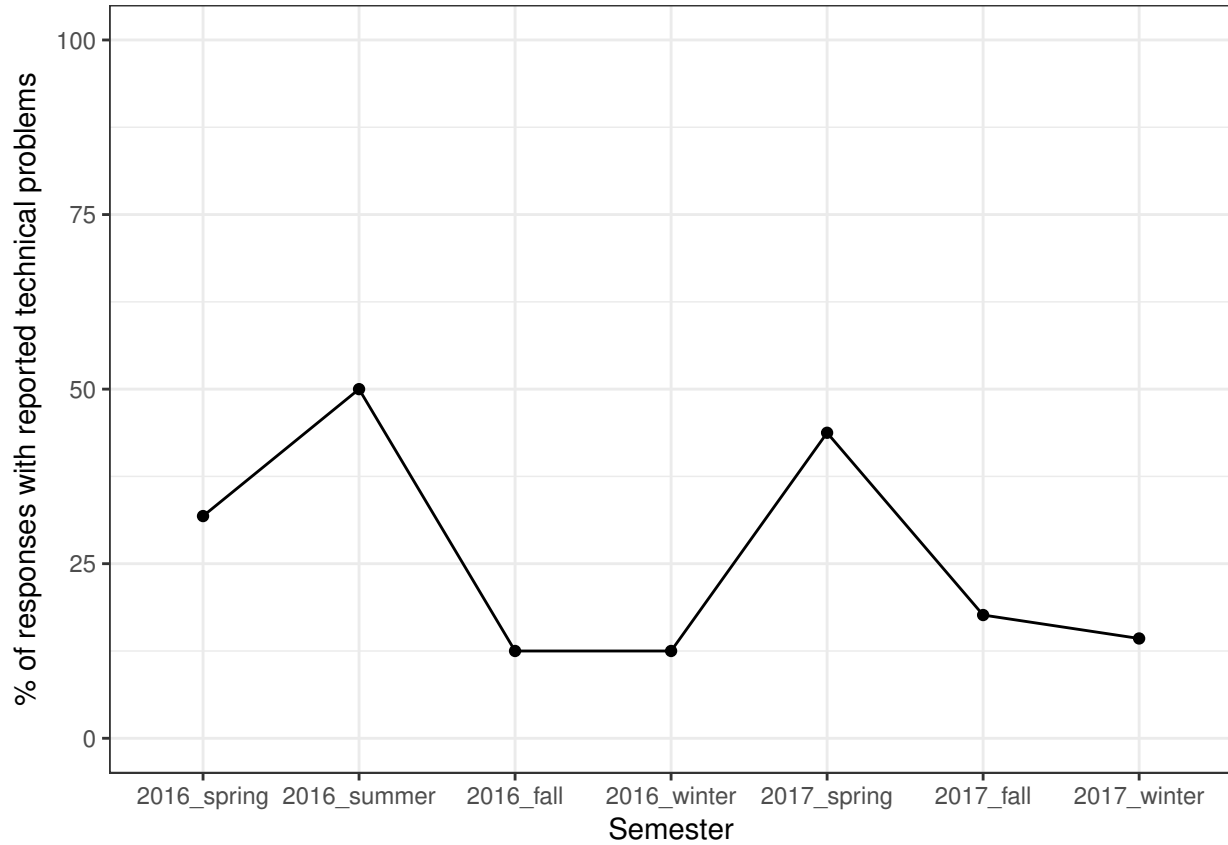

Line chart of the share of responses with reported technical problems for each semester



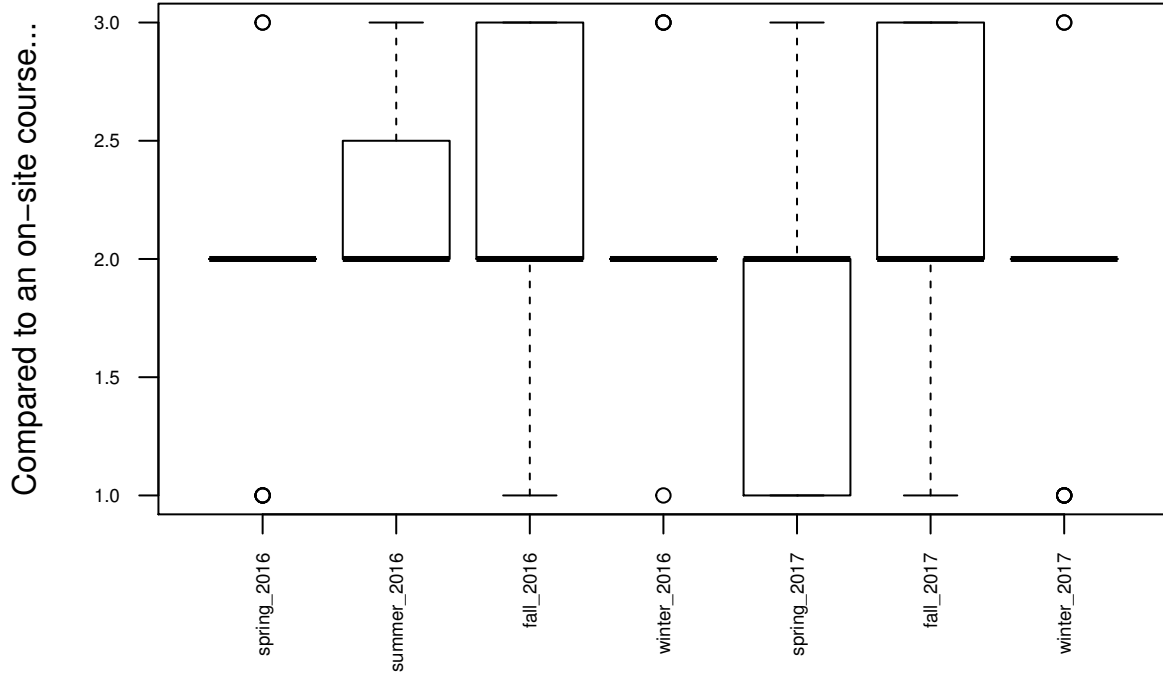
13a. Please describe the technical difficulties you had in the course

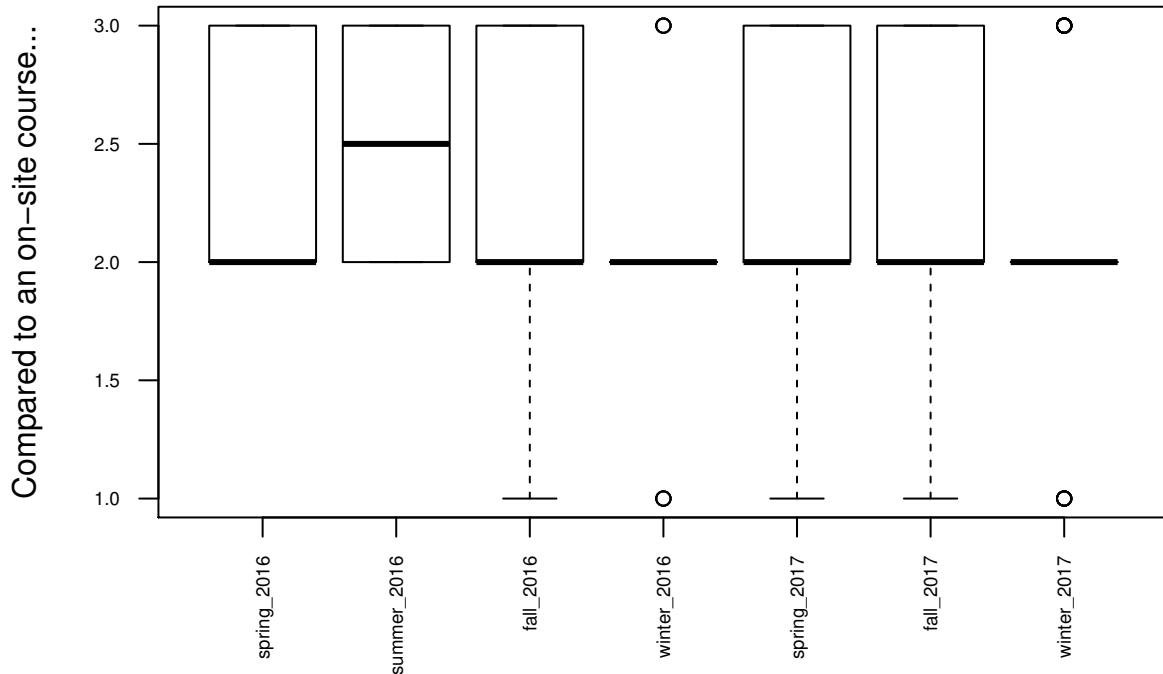
